

Eartheater

This "eartheater" grows up to 20 cm (8 in.) and can, due to its peaceful nature, easily be kept together with other species. Their name is due to their eating behavior: they take up sand or mud from the bottom ground and filters the edible component by means of a gill raker.

Frilled Lizard

Frilled lizards are considered a symbol for Australia. The diurnal tree inhabitants mainly eat insects and can erect their frill like an umbrella in case of being threatened. Since Frilled Lizards become rather big, growing to about 1 m (3.3 ft.) in length, they need appropriately plenty of space in the terrarium.
