

Quality, innovation and sustainability at sera: excellent





In 2022, sera received the award "pet product of the year" in the aquarium care category. This is an award by the specialized magazine "pet". Every year, German specialized pet retailers vote for the best products in an online reader poll. sera won this poll in the aquarium care category in 2020, 2021 and 2022 and thus brought the "triple" to Heinsberg. The winning products include: the sera Scaper Cubes with *innovative drop shipping concept* (2020), the *sustainable food concept* sera Insect Nature (2021) and sera siporax Nitrate-minus Professional – a well proven, high quality biological filter medium, reconsidered (2022).

These three values – innovation, sustainability and quality – have always been very important for sera.

But what do they mean for sera?

Innovation

Improving aquarium care with innovative products – that was the sera motto already early on. For instance, sera revolutionized the industry with a unique freeze drying process in the 1970s. It was possible for the first time to preserve various food animals such as bloodworms or Tubifex while optimally retaining their nutrients and vitamins. In the past, sera presented innovations time and again also in the care and technology ranges. The herbal medicine Phyto med Catappa against fungi, bacteria and ectoparasites, introduced in 2021, is a current example for this. It is the first medicine for aquarium care based on Catappa leaves. Due to the new, unique extraction process developed by sera, a maximum of medically active substances is being dissolved from the leaves.



Specialists from the biology, chemistry and veterinary medicine fields continuously work on new product solutions in the research laboratory of the company.



Sustainability

Being a medium sized, globally active enterprise, sera is aware about their responsibility towards man, animals and environment. The sustainability principle is firmly grounded in all enterprise processes – from production via transport up to sales. Sustainability is being maintained for decades at the headquarters in Heinsberg: The company had several big photovoltaics systems installed on the production site rooves already in the 1990s. Furthermore, a combined heat and power unit is in operation at the premises of the company in Heinsberg, which sera operates together with a regional energy provider. Further examples for practical sustainability: Both the administration building as well as the training, recreational and social rooms are heated with geothermal heat

and illuminated in an electricity saving way.









Quality

sera products are subject to strict quality requirements. Their fulfillment is permanently monitored in the on-site laboratory. The best example: the food for ornamental fish and reptiles. The food is manufactured bottled and shipped to retailers at the headquarters of the company in Heinsberg. For ensuring the high quality of the food continuously, quality control already begins when new raw materials are being delivered. Accompanying production, further samples are examined in the on-site

laboratory until the ready packed product is finally approved. The internal analyses are regularly confirmed by external laboratories. The food is approved for shipping once they fulfill all quality criteria.

These great animals grow up to 45 cm (18 in.). The coloration of the catfish is characteristic, since it changes when they get older. While juvenile fish are mainly gray, older fish first get yellow dots before the entire fish turns yellow.

Due to its size Golden sailfin plecos, like similar species, can only be kept in very big aquariums.

Splashing tetras have already been among the most popular aquarium fish for many years. The rather plain animals are mainly known for their exceptional breeding behavior. The animals leave the water for laying eggs and fertilizing them and jump to leaves above the water surface. They hold on there and slide back into the water after laying eggs and fertilizing them. The male then regularly splashes the eggs with fresh water.

These South America cichlids like it a bit warmer and well structured. In case the keeping conditions are not suitable and the animals thus do not feel well, they are often jumpy and retreat. Due to their long fins and a body height of up to 30 cm (12 in.) the swimming space should be at least 50 cm (20 in.), ideally even 60 cm (24 in.) high.

Butterfly Cichlid

These popular Butterfly Cichlids are the 'Electric Blue' fancy variant. The animals cannot be found in this coloration in their natural South American habitat. These rather small cichlids grow to 7 cm (3 in.) at the maximum and are well suited for keeping them together with peaceful tetras. They are thus also ideally suited for smaller community aquariums above 80 cm (31 in.) with densely growing plants.

Dwarf Pufferfish

Dwarf pufferfish like low currents and densely growing plants. The animals originate from Asia and do particularly well in a group only with members of their own species. Due to their size and the rather low swimming space requirements, keeping them is also possible in smaller aquariums above 60 cm (24 in.). Appropriate nutrition also includes regularly feeding small snails in this case so the continuously growing teeth can wear off.

Royal blue Macropode


The royal blue variant of black paradisefish is still a very new fancy variant. Like all macropodes, they as well belong to the labyrinth fish and thus require free access to the water surface. Due to their high temperature tolerance range (15 to 25°C; 59 to 77°F) they are also popular as pond fish in colder regions during summer. For instance, they are very well suited for seasonal small ponds.
